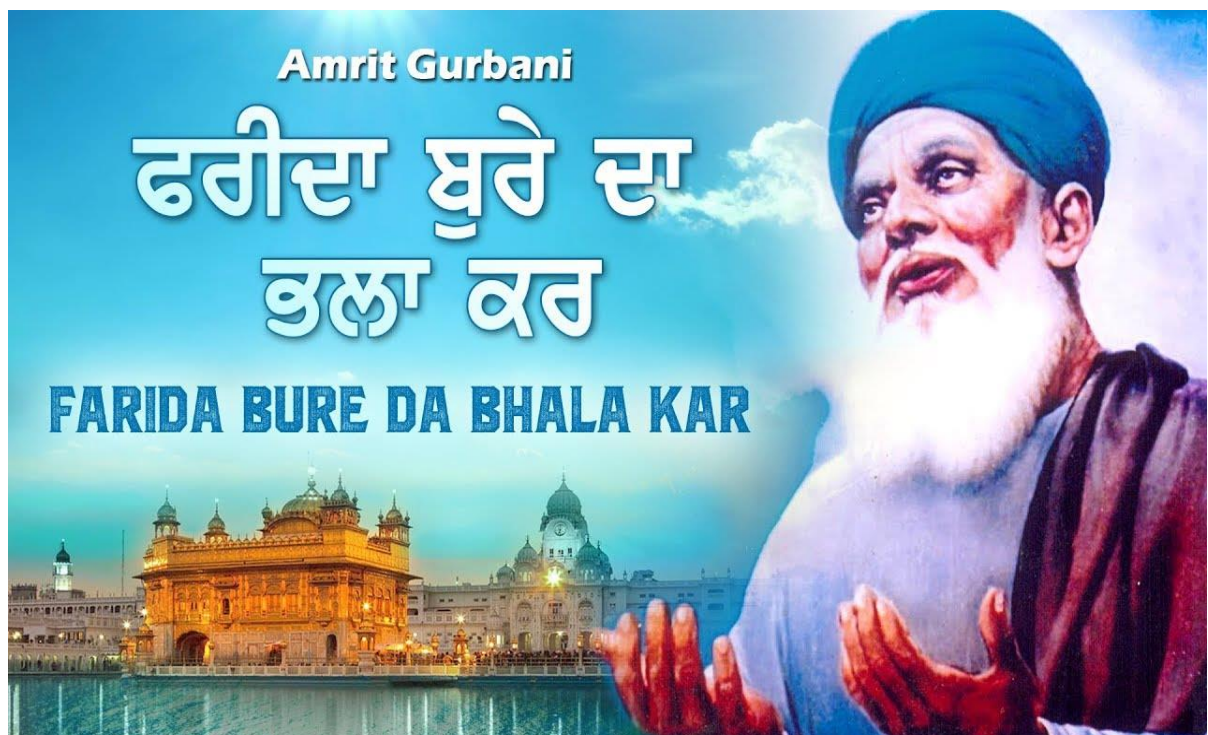
INSTITUTIONAL DISTINCTIVENESS SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY TOWARDS SOCIETY

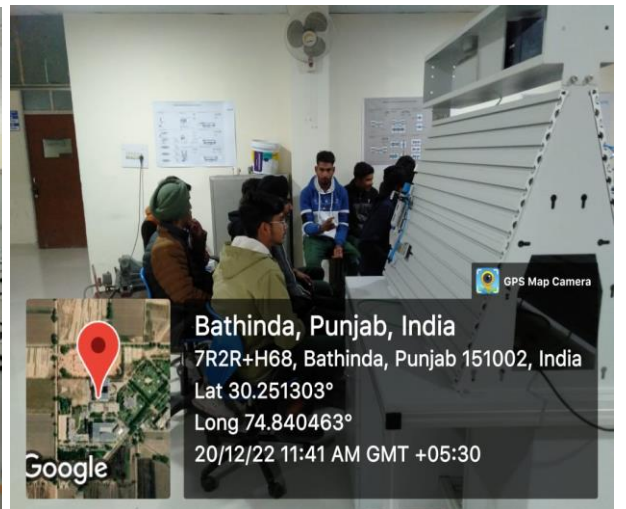


Figure 1: Glimpse on the workshop organized under Vindyaanjli Scheme

Congratulations to all the participating Institutions (PIs) selected under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, a flagship program of Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India. It is a challenge mode opportunity. The Mission of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan is to enable participating higher educational institutions to work with the people of rural India in identifying development challenges and devising appropriate solutions for accelerating sustainable growth. It also aims to foster a virtuous cycle between society and an Institute's academic system by providing knowledge and research for emerging professional and to upgrade the sustainability of local public and the private sectors as responding to the development needs of rural India.


As per the programme, participating institutions are primarily to develop linkage with selected rural clusters (consisting of five villages), to get involved in the planning process and to promote the requisite S&T interventions to improve and expedite the developmental efforts in those clusters. The approach is a departure from the grant oriented method and would see the participation and commitment of faculty and students in this endeavour.
