

The institution had arranged for a bus to take the students to the village of Peori, where they dispersed in groups of two to three people. By going door to door in the community, the students filled out the question naives for the house hold survey forms. Villagers discussed a bout their issues, facilities provided by government, pension's schemes, etc. in the village during the survey. Total 43 students participated in this activity.

Individuals who participated in the home survey told us about the difficulties they were having, but the majority of the villages had similar challenges. As they primarily rely on the agricultural sector, they have informed us about their sources of income. The majority of the village's roads have poor conditions due to which some time accidents also occur, and the second significant concern is dumping of waste as no proper space is allocated for the same. Additionally, students filled out information about farming land, livestock, Pesticides used by Farmers and other topics.

Sanitation is acritical aspect of public health that playsa crucial rolein ensuring the availability of safe drinking water and adequate sewage disposal. It involves creating a clean environment that minimizes the transmission of disease, particularly through the fecal-oral route. To raise awareness about the importance of sanitation, the NSS/NCC unit of Baba Farid College of Engineering & Technology collaborated with Navjug Club and organized a Sanitation Awareness Seminar in Village Kot Bhai, District Muktsar, on November 16, 2021. CLTS takes an approach to rural sanitation that works without hardware subsidies and that facilitates communities to recognize the problem of open defecation and take collective action to clean up and become "Open Defecation Free".



Er. Harsimran Singh shared his opinions and ideas with everyone by stating that, in many situations, the availability of sanitation facilities alone does not ensure the population's good health. He claimed that it was challenging to distinguish between promoting sanitation and boosting awareness of cleanliness. If a household has a toilet installed but fails to follow the appropriate hygiene practices, there will be less of a positive impact on the family's health. In the end, Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat appreciated the precious efforts of the NSS/NCC Unit of BFCET, Navjug Club, and the participants. He wished all the best to the students in their studies and future endeavors. There was a positive feeling among all the local people too who contributed to society. That was a worth while duty for the good of society, and in doing so, we can benefit not only our community but also our nation.
