- 1) To include topics on “**Electrical & Hybrid Vehicles**”: Fuel cell and its applications, Hybrid model of fuel cell based on solar and electrical vehicles, Simulations model of fuel cell and hybrid renewable energy system in Unit IV Course (BELED1-712 Electrical and Hybrid Vehicles).
- 2) Course on “**Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning in Electrical Engineering**” as department Elective-I (in 5<sup>th</sup> Semester of Electrical Engineering Department) as artificial intelligence and machine learning is going to affect every profession, and there are some electrical engineering fields in which AI and ML is bot to give a paradigm shift.


